Connecting with Nature at the Celery Fields is a photography competition to promote awareness of the value of having a Visitor and Nature Center at the Celery Fields. It is a juried photo contest with cash prizes: First place: \$150. | Second Place: \$100. | Third Place: \$50.

Here are the rules for submitting photos:

- All photos must be taken between April 25, Friday noon and Sunday night May 4.
- Photo subjects may include birds, wildlife, landscapes, people enjoying the Celery Fields.... – anything at the Celery Fields that makes you feel connected to nature.
- Photos must be submitted in a hi-res jpeg and emailed to suzanne@sarasotaaudubon.org;
- No entries accepted after 12:01 am, Monday, May 5.
- No more than three photos will be accepted.
- Johnson PhotoImaging is responsible for the judge's panel and all decisions are final.
- Winners will be announced on Sarasota Audubon Facebook page on Tuesday, May 6.
- Winning photos and other select participant photos will be shared online during the 2014 Giving Challenge in a low res format with photo credit.
