Barn Owl Nest Box to Get an Inside Look— Thanks to Green-Backyard

Sarasota Audubon Society is excited to announce a new partnership with Green Backyard, which has generously donated a bird box camera for one of our Barn Owl nest boxes. This innovative tool will allow us to observe the owls up close—right from inside the box!

Installation of the camera is planned for October 2025. Once it's live, we'll share a streaming link with our members and supporters so you can follow along—whether the owls are roosting during the day or actively nesting and raising young. Even outside the breeding season, the box may serve as a valuable roosting site, offering ongoing insight into the lives of these

community.

That's Wild: A Canada Goose being raised by Sandhill Cranes in Wisconsin

Families come in all shapes and sizes — and sometimes species.

In Madison, Wisconsin, a pair of sandhill cranes has apparently adopted a baby Canada goose, and they're



raising it as their own. This kind of cross-species adoption has only been documented a few times, including in 2011 when a goose was spotted living and behaving like a crane in Alaska.

Perhaps it's no surprise. Sandhill cranes and Canada geese are both highly adaptive species well-equipped to move through a variety of environments, including urban areas. <u>Watch a heartwarming video</u> of one of the parents with the adopted gosling and a baby crane (called a colt for their long legs).
